The GRACI foundation is pleased to announce that applications are open for the 2026 annual grant round. We welcome applications from researchers residing in New Zealand (NZ) affiliated with a NZ research organisation or healthcare provider, and who are involved in gynaecological cancer research.

Grants will be available to any researcher residing in NZ and affiliated with a NZ research organisation or healthcare provider. Grants will be awarded to support New Zealand research in gynaecological cancer in accordance with the documented goals of the GRACI foundation.

- *To improve outcomes for New Zealand women with gynaecological cancer.*
- *To support infrastructure for clinical research into the treatment or prevention of gynaecological cancer in New Zealand women.*
- *To support New Zealand researchers in the field of gynaecological cancer.*
- *To promote the conduct of new research in the field of gynaecological cancer.*

In 2026 there is one grant category:

1. Open to any gynaecological cancer research in New Zealand.
 - a. Grant funding of up to \$45,000.00 is available.
